

Stitch It Forward Society of Lethbridge

Mitten Pattern

1. Cut out your pattern pieces. You will have 6 in total. Lay them out to ensure you have a left and a right mitten.
2. With good sides together, sew the thumb and palm seam together.
3. Sew, good sides together, the two halves to the mitten. Leaving the bottom open. Make sure the thumb is tucked in and not going to get sew into the side.
4. Trim the bottom
5. Turn the mitten so good side is out. Stretch the crochet / knit cuff onto to bottom of the mitten and sew two times. If the cuff is knit, fold it over before sewing so the cuff is double layered.



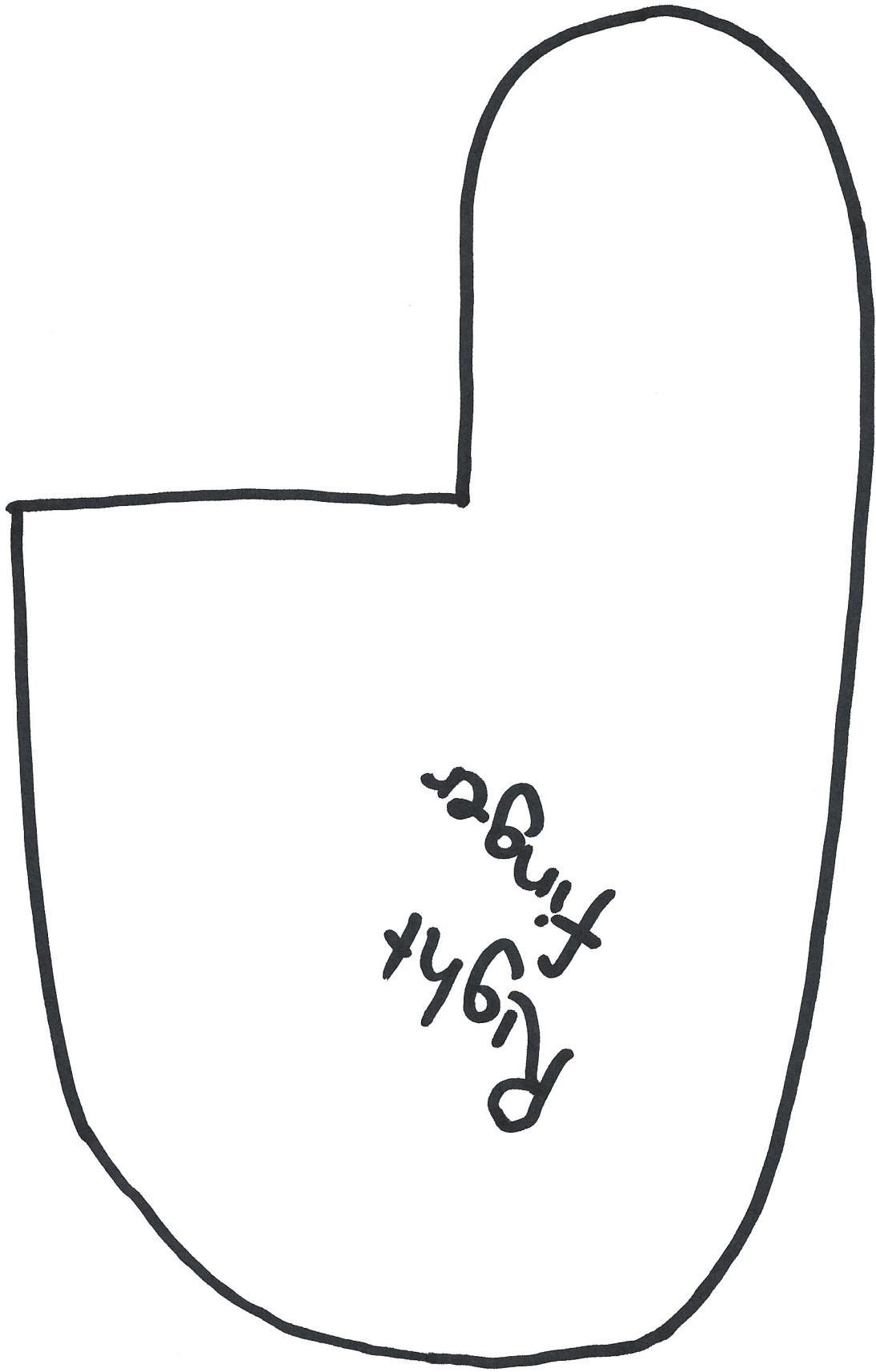
Crochet Cuff

Chain 12
Turn
2 chain from hook sc, then sc to end
Chain 1, turn
Sc across (11 stitches)
Back and forth until between 6.5" and 7"
Fold in half to make a ring
Sc both sides together
Tuck in strings
Make 2
Tie pairs together with a scrap piece of string

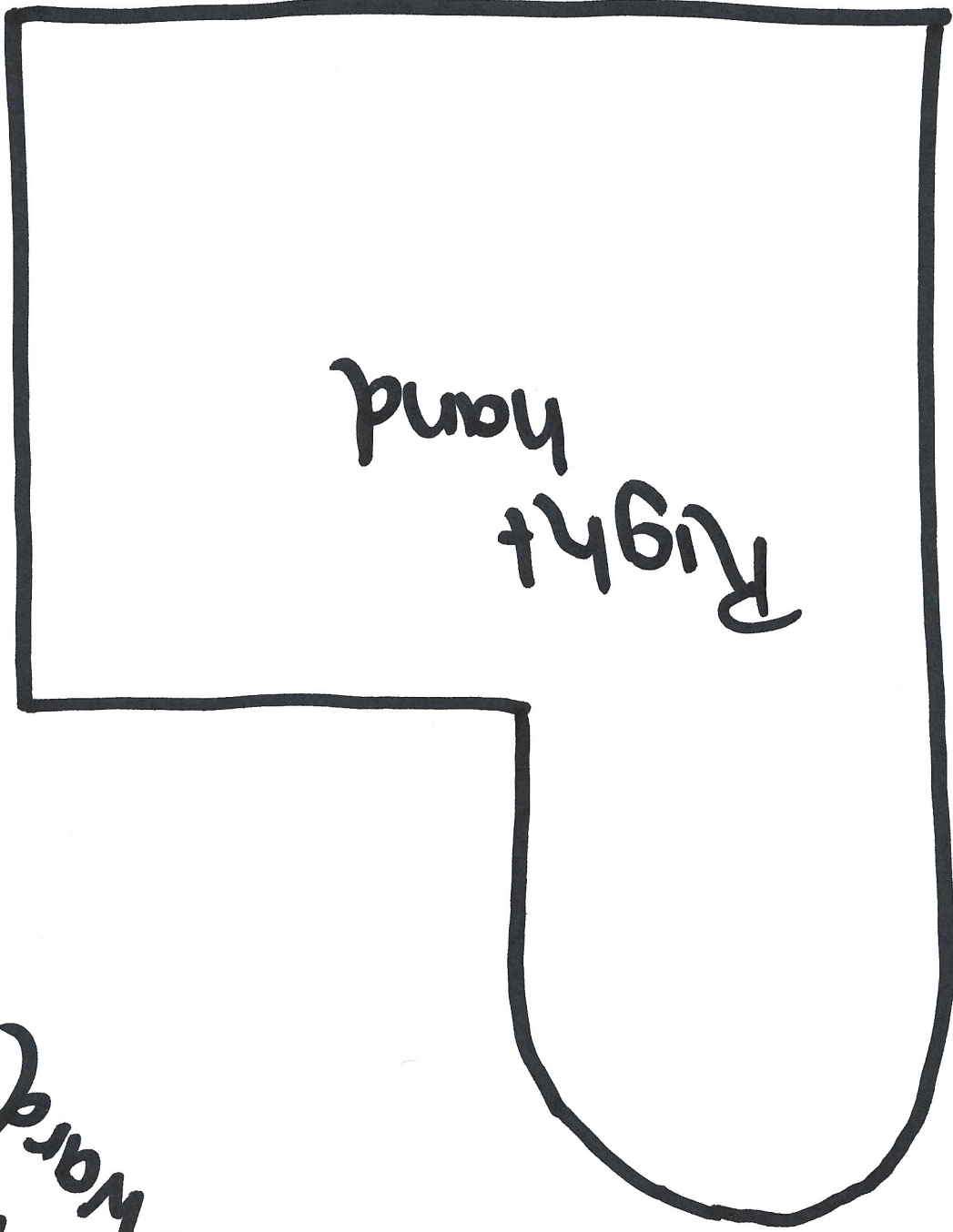
Knit Cuff

Cast on enough stitches to be 8" long.
Knit one, Purl one until it is about 7" long.
Sew ends together to make a circle.

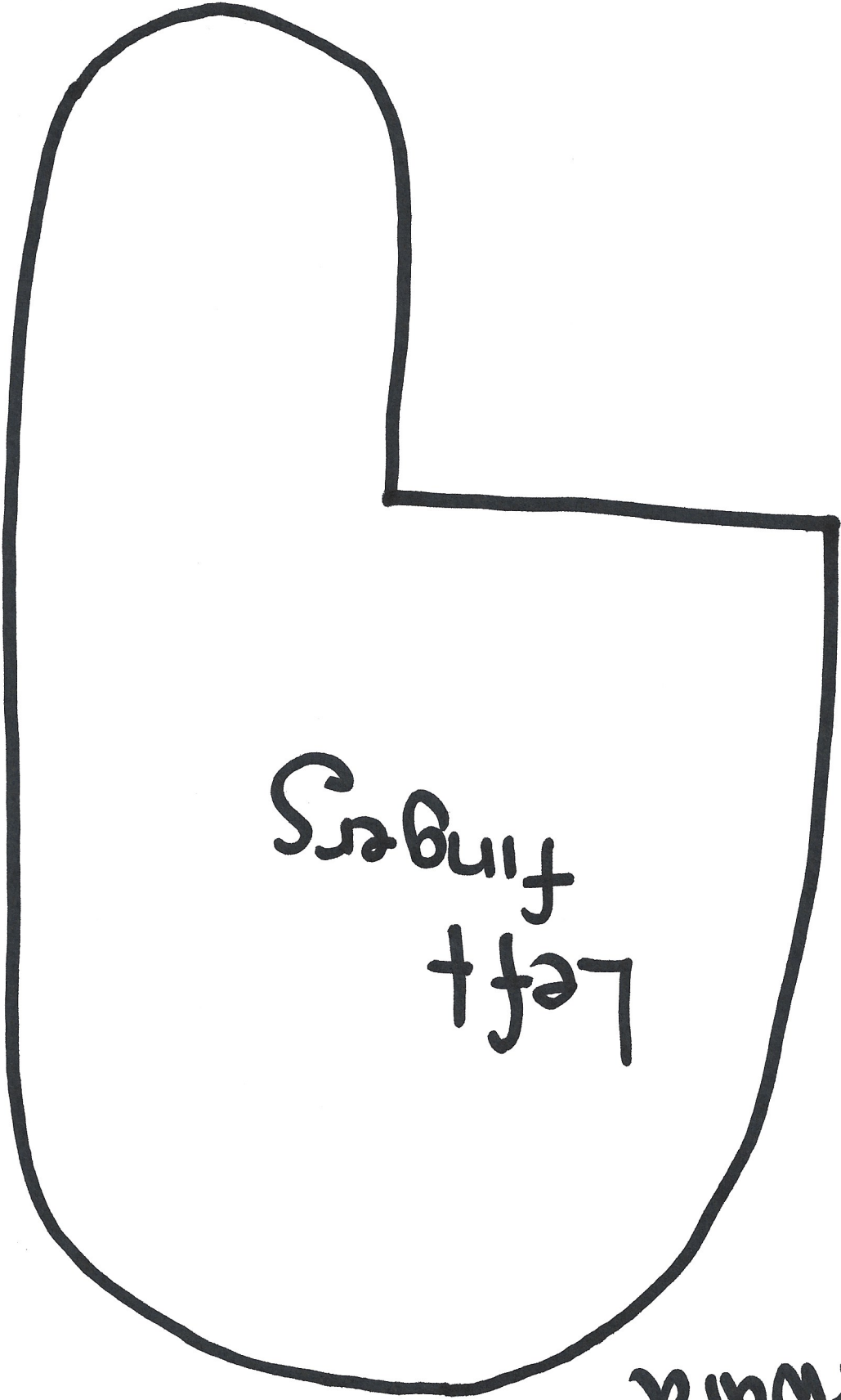
Stitch it forward
